### ⓐ Comma (Unnecessary), Spelling, Comma (Other)

### ⓐ Comma (Nonrestrictive Phrase or Clause), Subject-Verb Agreement, Comma (Other)

### ⓐ Semicolon, Comma (Other), Spelling

Pet iguanas like to sit in high places however it is still a surprise when one jumps onto your head.

### ⓐ Run-On Sentence, Using the Right Word, Spelling

Allowing species to become extinct is a big risk its imposible for us to know which missing species will upset the whole balence of the earth.

### ⓐ Italics (Underlining), Comma (Nonrestrictive Phrase or Clause), Using the Right Word, Spelling
