ⓐ Comma (Nonrestrictive Phrase or Clause), Subject-Verb Agreement, Comma (Other)

ⓐ Semicolon, Comma (Other), Spelling

ⓐ Run-On Sentence, Using the Right Word, Spelling

ⓐ Italics (Underlining), Comma (Nonrestrictive Phrase or Clause), Using the Right Word, Spelling
