### ⓐ Colon, Semicolon, Abbreviation, Punctuation (Title)

She closed the book and looked at the clock <sup>^</sup>she had finished reading The Elder  
Brothers at exactly 12:00 <sup>^</sup>AM.

### ⓑ Quotation Marks, Hyphen, End Punctuation, Comma (Other)

“Hey <sup>^</sup>Elena <sup>^</sup>asked Steven Baron <sup>^</sup>Sr. <sup>^</sup>as we unpacked <sup>^</sup>did you forget the grapes <sup>^</sup>? You  
forgot the T <sup>^</sup>shirts, too? Oh, brother <sup>^</sup>!”

### ⓒ Semicolon, Comma (Appositive), Spelling, Comma (Other)

The lungfish <sup>^</sup>an unusual animal <sup>^</sup>has both lungs and gills <sup>^</sup>therefore <sup>^</sup>it can ~~breath~~  
<sup>^</sup>*breathe*  
~~either~~  
<sup>^</sup>*either* underwater or on land.

### ⓓ Punctuation (Title), Comma (Nonrestrictive Phrase or Clause), Using the Right Word, Comma (Other)

Tom Cruise <sup>^</sup>~~stared~~  
<sup>^</sup>*starred* in the remake of War of the Worlds <sup>^</sup>which was released on June  
<sup>^</sup>29, 2005 across the country.

### ⓔ Comma (Nonrestrictive Phrase or Clause), Using the Right Word, Dashes

Holistic medicine <sup>^</sup>which includes treatments such as acupuncture and aromatherapy  
<sup>^</sup>*whole* focuses on treating the ~~hole~~ person <sup>^</sup>body and mind <sup>^</sup>rather ~~then~~  
<sup>^</sup>*than* just the ~~effected~~  
<sup>^</sup>*affected* part.
