### ⊗ Comma (Appositive), Italics (Underlining), Comma (Other), Plurals, Using the Right Word

### ⊗ Comma (Unnecessary), Spelling, Numbers

Oxygen was ~~discovered~~<sup>discovered</sup> in 1772 by the ~~Swedish~~<sup>Swedish</sup> chemist<sup>^</sup> Carl Scheele, but he withheld the information until ~~2~~<sup>two</sup> years later when Joseph Priestly made the same ~~discovery~~<sup>discovery</sup>.

### ⊗ Comma (Other), Using the Right Word, Abbreviation

### ⊗ Parentheses (or Dashes), Comma (Other), End Punctuation

### ⊗ Comma (Nonrestrictive Phrase or Clause), Abbreviation, Comma (Other), Spelling
